12. The Committee decided to enter in the World Heritage List the following 28 sites : (...)

The representative from Italy agreed to communicate to his Government the Committee's recommendation to extend the protected zone on the Western side as far as the walls built by Urban VIII.

The Committee considered it desirable that the Vatican City be also protected under the World Heritage Convention and therefore recommended that an invitation to accede to the Convention be addressed by the General Conference of Unesco to the Holy See.
